ARTICLE 2. To see if the town will vote to authorize the select board to spend an amount not to exceed \$ 48,078 in an account named revenue sharing to ratify over expenditures in the accounts for Town Expenses and Professional Services of 2026-2027 fiscal year and to conduct a forensic audit on the town financials.
 - ii. Other Options
ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to ratify overdrafts in expenditures of Professional Services of \$17,724.00 for the fiscal 2026-2027 year from the account named Revenue Sharing.
ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to ratify overdrafts in expenditures of Town Expenses of \$6,885.00 for the 2026-2027 fiscal year from the account named Revenue Sharing.
ARTICLE 4. To see if the Town will vote to allow the Selectboard to spend an amount not to exceed \$23,469.00 in an account named Revenue Sharing to conduct a forensic audit on the Town financials.
